Report on the "MANAGEMENT GAMES"

Introduction:

The KAIZEN Club, under the guidance of faculty coordinator T.Swetha, successfully organized a one-day Management games for MBA Ist and IInd year students on April 7th, 2025. The "Management Games" event, held from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM, provided a practical platform for participants to engage with core management competencies, including team building, coordination, active listening, and team management.

Event Highlights:

- ➤ The "Management Games" event featured four distinct, multi-round activities designed to evaluate key management skills: Team Building, Team Coordination, Team Management, and Listening Skills. The program witnessed significant participation, with approximately 100 attendees and 14 teams, each comprising five individuals.
- The event structure incorporated four interactive, skill-based games that assessed various facets of teamwork, coordination, management, and communication. The initial activity, Team Building, facilitated by Garima and D. Mounika, resulted in the progression of four teams to the final stage and the subsequent shortlisting of two. The second game, Team Coordination, hosted by R.K. Sreeya and Ajay, challenged participants' collaborative and planning capabilities, leading to seven teams advancing to the second round, three to the third, and ultimately two being shortlisted. The Team Management game, conducted by Bharathi and Prateek, focused on evaluating strategic thinking, with four teams reaching the final round and two being selected. The concluding activity, Listening Skills, hosted by Gopi Krishna and Sai Swetha, assessed participants' attentiveness, with four teams entering the finals and two being shortlisted.
- Throughout the competition, participants exhibited commendable teamwork, rapid problem-solving abilities, and effective communication. The event culminated in the recognition of high-performing teams as winners and runners-up, underscoring the program's success in providing a memorable and enriching experiential learning opportunity.
